<u>Stephen Ministers</u> are laypeople who have been trained through the Stephen Series in the theology of caring and in specific caring skills.

BACKGROUND OF STEPHEN MINISTRY

In Acts 6:1-7, Stephen is identified as one of the first laypeople set aside to do caring ministry. Kenneth Haugk, an ordained minister and clinical psychologist, picked Stephen as the image for the lay caregiving program he started in 1975 to meet the needs of his own congregation. Dr. Haugk is the executive director of Stephen Ministries St. Louis. Leader's Training Courses began in 1978. Since then, more than 12,000 congregations have trained Stephen Leaders.
